

## ST. MARK'S SUMMER DAY CAMP 2010

Our summer enrichment program will begin June 21 and conclude August 27. There will be two five week sessions. A weekly rate is also available. If you would like to enroll your child into the summer day camp program, please complete the attached form and return it to the school office.

A variety of opportunities and activities are being offered to give many learning experiences. The program will include academic subjects (morning), field trips, games, picnics at the park, bowling and movies.

For the morning sessions each child will be placed in a class by current grade level. When their class reaches the maximum number of students it will be closed. Any additional applicants will be placed on a waiting list. Parents will be notified when openings become available. Enrollment forms to be completed and returned by May 21.

ENROLLMENT FEE is required for the summer. A \$75.00 fee will be collected at the time of registration. **The initial fee is non-refundable.**

FEES cover all activities and field trips. Spending money is optional on field trips.

LUNCH IS NOT INCLUDED. Your child must bring a lunch every day. Cost of the program on a full time basis (6:30 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.) Monday through Friday will be:

Weekly rates are \$165.00 for the first child, \$135.00 for the second child and \$105.00 for the third or more. **Fees must be paid on or before June 7 for the first session and by July 12 for the second session.**

ALL STUDENTS MUST GO AND RETURN ON THE BUS.**

**ACADEMIC ONLY CLASSES:** Charges for academics only, Monday – Thursday, 9:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. is \$320.00 for a five week session. There is no discount for the second child.

**All academic only students MUST be picked up at 11:30 am. NO daycare will be provided.**

St. Mark's summer academic program offers a variety of activities in the areas of reading, science, study skills, mathematics and social studies.

The summer class for 4<sup>th</sup> graders going into 5<sup>th</sup> grade will focus on having students make a successful transition from a single teacher to a rotating class schedule. Emphasis will be on mathematics, the Step-Up-To-Writing process and the class book for the 5<sup>th</sup> grade summer reading will be read.

Students going into grades 6-8 will work on the summer required reading, mathematics and Step-Up-To-Writing.

Students in mandatory summer school due to low grade point averages will be the only group that will receive letter grades. These students must earn a 2.0 grade point average for the session and must turn in 100% of their homework on time if they wish to return to St. Mark's in the fall.
